

Privacy policy Kraket

Introduction

We are aware that you have confidence in us. We therefore see it as our responsibility to protect your privacy. In this document we will let you know what data we collect when you are a member of Kraket, why we collect this data and for what purposes the data is used. This way you understand exactly how we work.

This privacy policy applies to the services of Kritische Aktuarissen en Econometristen (hereinafter: Kraket). You should be aware that Kraket is not responsible for the privacy policy of other sites and sources that can be mentioned on the website www.kraket.nl or subdomains.

Kraket respects the privacy of all users of its site and ensures that the personal information you provide is treated confidentially. Kraket in all cases adheres to the applicable laws and regulations, including the General Data Protection Regulation.

This privacy statement will sometimes be changed because of, for example, amendments to the law. It is therefore advisable to periodically consult this policy.

Processing of personal data

When you sign up for a membership at Kraket, we ask you to provide personal information. This data is processed by Kraket for the following purposes:

- Administrative purposes;
- Contacting you and providing information;
- Providing a membership.

For the above purposes, Kraket may request the following personal data from you:

- Name;
- Address;
- Residence;
- Phone number;
- E-mail address;
- Date of birth;
- Sex;



- Bank details;
- Credentials;
- Student number;
- Study and academic year.

The data is stored on Kraket's own secure servers or those of a third party. The data that is required to be delivered are the minimum required data for the provision of the Kraket services. If this mandatory information is not provided, Kraket cannot provide a membership.

Your personal data will be stored by Kraket for the above processing for the following period:

- During the term of the membership, and then for the period of one year in an old-member file. We use this file to provide information about, among other things, the alumni association. After this period the personal data will only be stored in the financial administration for a maximum of seven years.

Purposes

We do not collect or use your personal information for purposes other than the purposes described in this Privacy Policy, unless we have obtained your permission in advance.

Third parties

We may provide the personal data you provide to us to third parties if this is necessary for the execution of the aforementioned purposes. For example, we use a third party for:

- Sending the newsletter and other mailings;
- Taking care of the internet environment.

We never pass on personal data to parties with whom we have not made a processor agreement. Furthermore, we will not provide the personal data you provide to other parties, unless this is legally required and permitted, or unless we have obtained your permission in advance.

Storage period

Kraket will never store personal data for longer than necessary for the purpose for which the data was provided, or is required by law.

Security

Kraket has taken appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your personal data against unlawful processing. Examples of these measures are:

- All persons who can view your data on behalf of Kraket must conform to the confidentiality of the data;
- The Kraket domain is protected against hacking by means of an SSL security certificate;
- We use a username and password policy on all our systems;
- The devices that open your data are each also locked with a password and/or fingerprint.



Communication

When you send e-mail or other messages to us, we may retain those messages. Sometimes we ask you for your personal details that are relevant to the situation in question. This makes it possible to process your questions and answer your requests. The data is stored on Kraket's own secure servers or those of a third party. We will not combine this information with other personal information we have.

Cookies

We collect data for research in order to gain a better insight into our members, so that we can tailor our services accordingly.

The website 'www.kraket.nl' uses 'cookies' (text files that are placed on your computer) in order to analyze how users use the site. The information generated by cookies about your use of the website can be transferred to Kraket's own secure servers or those of a third party. We use this information to keep track of how you use the website, and thereby improve the user-friendliness of the website.

Rights

You have the right to view, change, or delete any personal information we hold about you. You have the right to limit and object to the processing of your personal data. You also have the right to have the information provided by us transferred to you or on your behalf directly to another party. You can use these rights by submitting a request via the contact details below. We can ask you to identify you before we respond to these requests. The data that we process from you are the minimum required data for the provision of the Kraket services. Limiting or objecting to the processing of your data may lead to an exclusion from membership of Kraket.

If you have given permission to process your personal data, you always have the right to withdraw this consent.

Questions and complaints

We regularly check whether we comply with this privacy policy. If you have questions or comments about our privacy policy, please contact us using the contact details below.

We also request you to contact us directly if you have a complaint about the processing of your personal data. In this way we hope to find a solution together. You always have the right to file a complaint with the Dutch Data Protection Authority.
